

Bucks County Grant Program to Pay Delinquent Mortgages for Qualifying Individuals and Families Who Have Experienced Reduced Income as a Result of the COVID-19 Pandemic

The Bucks County CARES Foreclosure Assistance and Foreclosure Counseling Program, made possible by a grant secured by the Bucks County Housing and Community Development Office, is designed to provide financial assistance, as well as foreclosure counseling services, to individuals and families who are delinquent in their mortgage payments and who have experienced job loss or reduced income as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic.

While funds last, the grant will pay the delinquent mortgage amount for individuals who meet the unemployment, income, mortgage, property and eligibility requirements.
