On January 24, 2023

320 people were in emergency shelter, transitional housing, or outdoors in Bucks County. This is a \approx 25% decrease from the number of people counted last January.

42 or 13% chronically homeless households experiencing long-term or repeated episodes of homelessness









Adults and Children on the Night of the PIT Count


